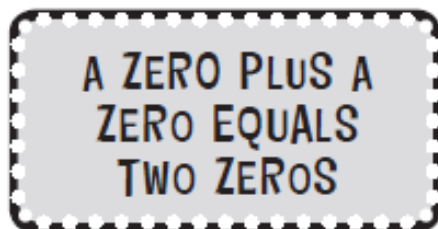


Read these words aloud and try using them in a sentence.
