Shall we do some music today? You can listen to me singing some of our known songs on Riverside Primary School website and you can also access many songs via:

To start off, can the adult in your household put on some lively music? I would recommend for today this song:

Can you follow the instructions to move your body? Can you listen again and jump up and down to the beat?

Now we've finished our song let us wake up our bodies some more.

Can you listen to the song I've recorded on the school website called '**Clap, clap, clap your hands**'? And sing along with your adult?

**Clap, clap, clap our hands – clap our hands together**  
**Stamp, stamp, stamp our feet, stand our feet together**  
**Tap, tap, tap our knees, tap our knees together**  
**Rub, rub, rub our bellies, rub our bellies together**  
**Roll, roll, roll our shoulders, roll our shoulders together**  
**Tap, tap, tap our heads, tap our heads together**

Do you remember this song from last week?

**Lion, where are you? Lion, where are you?**  
**Here I am, here I am. I see you and you and you!**

**Monkey, where are you? Monkey, where are you?**  
**Here I am, here I am. I see you and you and you!**

**....., where are you etc.**

We sang it with actions for each animal; moving our paws forward for “lion”, shrugging our shoulders for “where are you?”, pointing to ourselves for “here I am” and pointing at others/around the room for “I see you and you and you”.

Can you think of any other animals to add to our song and put an action to each one? Remember an action is with our body and so we still sing the animal name.

**Jack in the box, Jack in the box, stand up tall!**  
**Jack in the box, Jack in the box, curl up small.**

Can you start on the floor curled up and when you sing the word “tall” jump up high! And when singing “curl up small” slowly start to curl your body into a ball on the floor?

We have been singing the chorus of **‘Just a Spoonful of Sugar’** from **Mary Poppins** in singing assembly. Could you put the YouTube video on and sing along?
