

## Literacy activity - 2.7.20

Today we are going to continue with our work on the story 'Max's Morning Walk' from yesterday. You might want to begin by reading or listening to the story. You can listen to the story at: <https://soundcloud.com/talkforwriting/max/s-FEjkqo3nza0>

### You should

Today we are going to be thinking about the order of the story and what happened at the **beginning, middle** and **end**. Have a good look at the pictures of Max and then see if you can work out what order they should be in. You might need to read the story again to work out the right order. If you have a printer, you could print this sheet off and number each of the 5 pictures from the story.

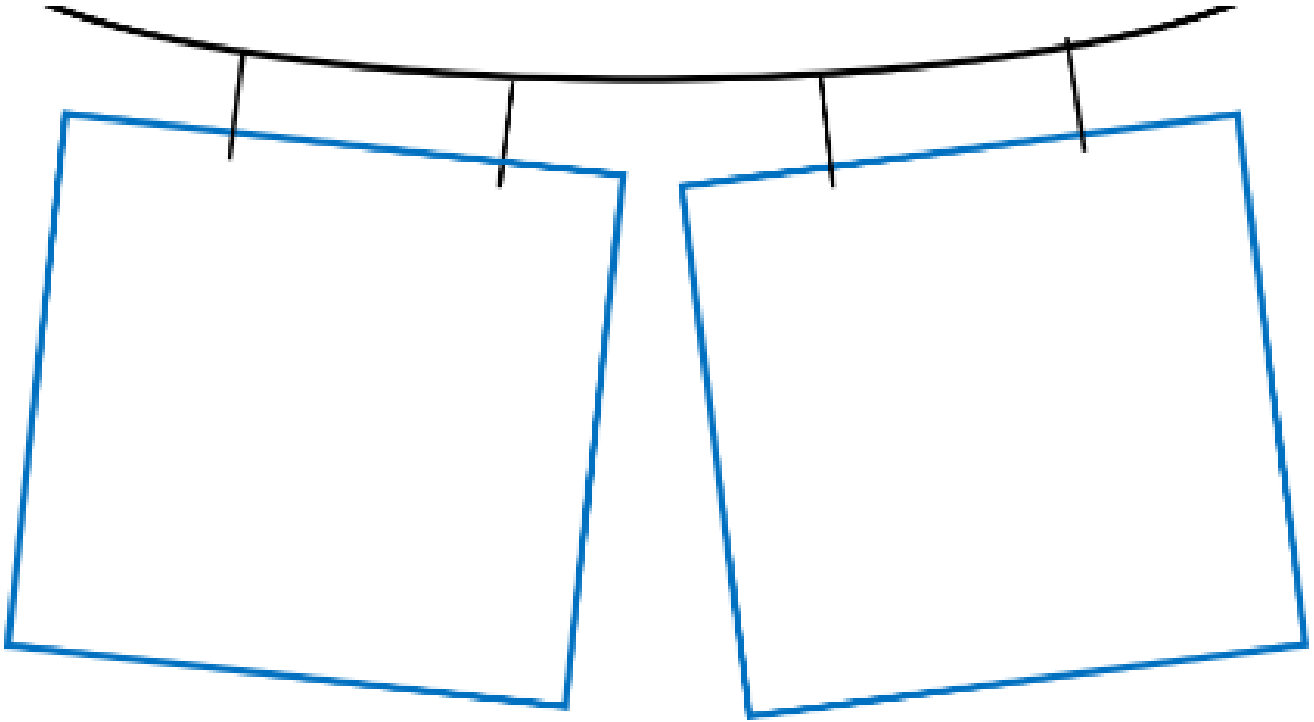
It might help you to think about:

- *Where did Max go first?*
- *Where did he go next?*
- *Where did he go after that?*
- *Where did he finally go before he returned home?*

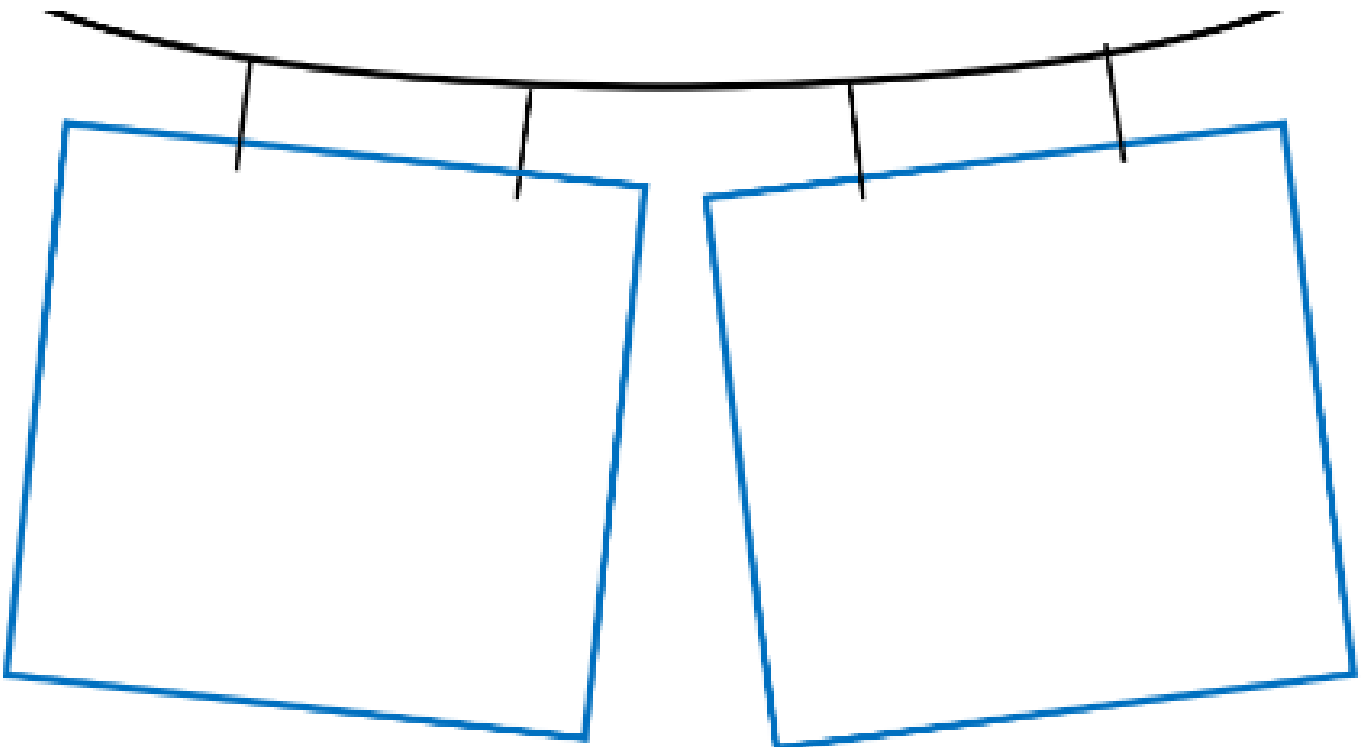


Now you've got the pictures in the correct order you will see that they are all from the **middle** of the story. See if you can draw your own pictures to show what happened at the **beginning** and **end** of the story.

Draw two things that Max did at the **end** of the story.

If you want a challenge, you could draw or write about what happened at the beginning, middle and **end** of the story along this story path. Remember to say your sentences before you write them down to check that they make sense. You should also put a full stop at the end of each sentence.
