

Literacy activity 13.7.20

This week we are going to continue consolidating our phonics.

To start

Show the children the sounds below. Point to a sound and ask your child to say the sound that the letters make. You could make this into a game. For example, you say a sound and your child points to it or you point to a sound and they have to say it. You could also see how many words you can think of with each sound in.

Today we are going to read words containing the sounds above. On the next page, there are some words in boxes. Your child needs to read the word, remind them to look for the digraph sounds, and then draw a picture to match. If you don't have a printer, you could write the words out on a piece of paper and then ask your child to draw a picture underneath.

Write a sentence using each of the words; it can be a silly sentence if you want! Remember your finger spaces and to sound out each word.
