Today we are going to be thinking about the order of the story and what happened at the **beginning, middle** and **end**. Have a good look at the pictures of Mouse and then see if you can work out what order they should be in. You might need to read the story again to work out the right order. If you have a printer, you could print this sheet off, cut out the pictures and arrange them into the correct order.

It might help you to think about:

- *Where did Mouse go first?*
- *Where did he go the next day?*



On the next page, there are some sentences from the story and pictures of Mouse. Support your child to read the sentences and then draw a line matching them to the correct picture.

He found him on his bedroom shelf in amongst the Lego models.



He found him in the kitchen cupboard, covered in flour.



He found him in the lounge, hanging from the curtain rail.
