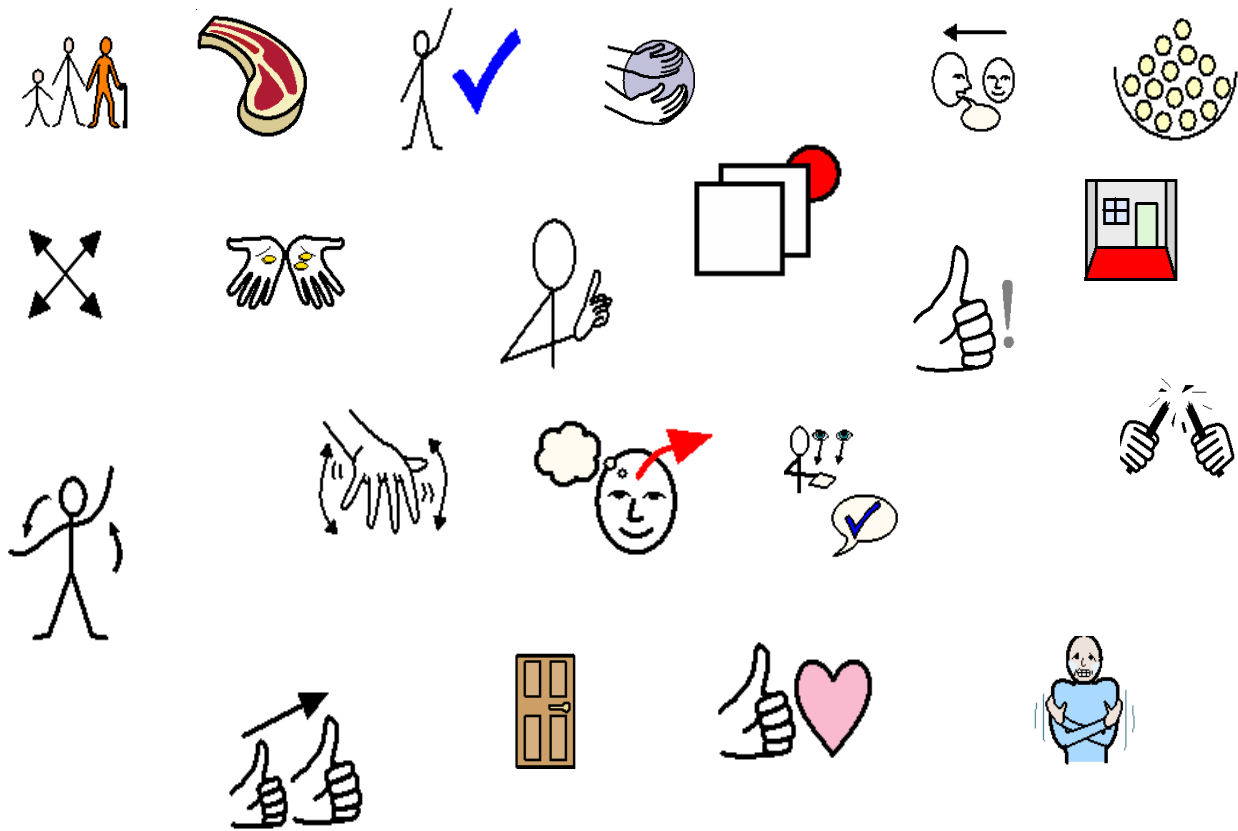

L.O. To use adverbs to show 'how' and 'when'

Adverbs can show us 'how' or 'when' something happens.

Look at the table below:

'how'	'when'
quickly, slowly, desperately, loudly, happily, silently, horribly, suddenly, unexpectedly, evilly, cheerfully, unfortunately	immediately, later, after, soon, afterwards, next, eventually
