

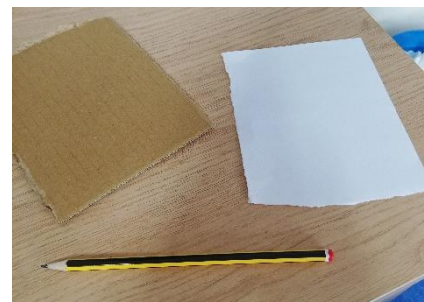
## Topic – week beginning 6<sup>th</sup> July 2020

### Creative Development

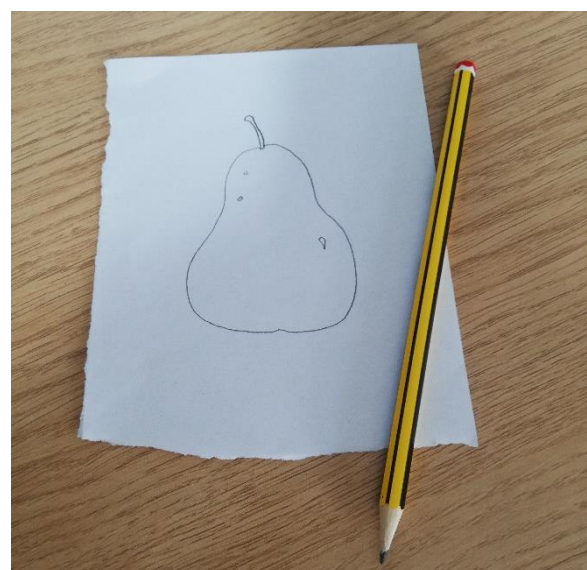


Today we will be learning how to make our own stamps! You will need:

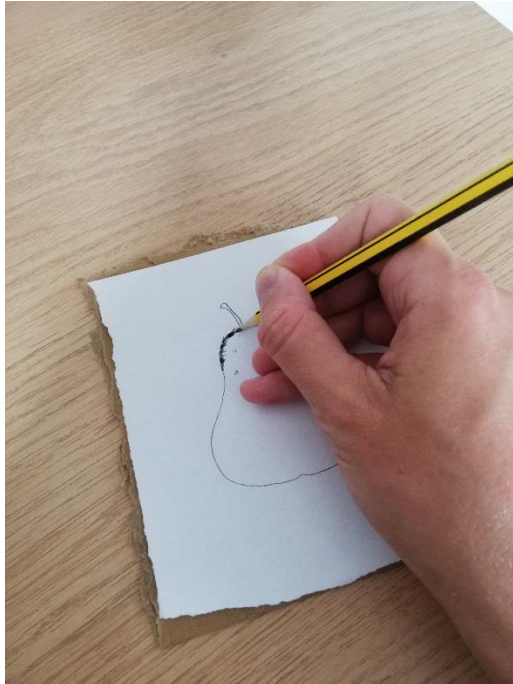
- Pencil
- Paper
- Scissors
- A piece of corrugated cardboard (the flap from a cardboard box will be perfect)
- Paint/ink & roller/brush (to use the stamp to print with)



Firstly, draw a simple picture on paper. You might like to carry on with our fruit theme and draw your favourite fruit. It needs to be simple so it is clear when you come to printing with it.



Next, place your picture on top of the card and trace along the same lines, pressing down hard so that the pencil makes grooves into the cardboard. These grooves won't take in paint when you print so will leave white lines. Your child might need help to press deep enough & you may need to go over the lines again once you have taken the paper off.



Now you will be able to roll or brush paint or ink onto your stamp and print it onto paper. Make sure when you're printing that you lift the stamp carefully to avoid smudging.
