<p>CVC words- A word that is made up of a consonant, vowel, consonant sound e.g. cat, dog, hat</p> <p>Medial sounds- the middle sound of a word e.g. sun, pin, tap</p> <p>Finger spaces- the space left between each word in a sentence</p> <p>Full stops- punctuation used at the end of the sentence e.g. Goldilocks was tired.</p> <p>Capital letters- letters used at the beginning of a sentence and for a proper noun e.g. I live in London. Goldilocks ate the porridge.</p>
