Weave – form (fabric or a fabric item) by interlacing long threads passing in one direction with others at a right angle to them. Spin- draw out and twist (the fibres of wool, cotton, or other material) to convert them into yarn, either by hand or with machinery. Braid – threads of silk, cotton, or other material woven into a decorative band for edging or trimming garments. Embroidery- decorate (cloth) by sewing patterns on it with thread. Pattern - a model or design used as a guide in needlework and other crafts.
