Temperature- measuring temperature in Maths		Identify daily weather patterns in the UK		Seasons- Each of the four divisions of the year (spring, summer, autumn, and winter) marked by particular weather patterns and daylight hours. Winter- The coldest and darkest season of the year, between autumn and spring. Spring- In the UK, Spring starts in March until the end of May. Temperatures start to rise and plants begin to bloom. Summer- Typically the hottest and sunniest months of the year- running from June until September. Autumn- The transition from summer to Winter. Temperatures begin to fall and leaves drop from plants and trees.
