Key Vocabulary/definitions

Safety – being protected from or unlikely to cause danger, risk, or injury
Secret – when someone is expected to keep it hidden for a long time or forever
Surprise – will be revealed at some point and we are not keeping it hidden for a long time
Cooperate – work jointly together
Respect - regard for the feelings, wishes, or rights of others
