<p>Links to other history topics include: Romans, Vikings</p> <p>Links to other curriculum subjects: Geography – Location of places, place names Literacy – Anglo-saxon Riddles and Kennings RE – Arrival of Christianity in Britain</p>	<p>Know and understand history as a chronological narrative</p> <p>Understand the reasons for the Saxon invasion of Britain</p> <p>Develop a secure knowledge and understanding of key features of the Anglo-Saxon period</p> <p>Establish clear narratives within and across the Anglo-Saxon period including the coming of Christianity to Britain</p> <p>Understand the historical concept of continuity and change, using this to make connections and draw contrasts</p> <p>Understand how and why contrasting arguments and interpretations of the past have been constructed</p> <p>Address historically valid questions about significance e.g. Does Alfred really deserve the title 'the Great'?</p>	<p>Chronology – the science of locating historical events in time</p> <p>Saxon - a member of a people that inhabited parts of central and northern Germany from Roman times, many of whom conquered and settled in much of southern England in the 5th–6th centuries.</p> <p>Angle - member of a Germanic people, which, together with the Jutes, Saxons, and probably the Frisians, invaded the island of Britain in the 5th century CE. The Angles gave their name to England, as well as to the word English.</p> <p>Pagan - a person holding religious beliefs other than those of the main world religions</p> <p>Christianity - the religion based on the person and teachings of Jesus Christ, or its beliefs and practices</p> <p>Historian - an expert in or student of history</p> <p>Primary Source - a document, first-hand account, or other source that was created at the time under study</p> <p>Secondary Source - a book, article, or other source that provides information about the time under study but does not include direct, first-hand evidence</p>
