### Key Vocabulary/definitions

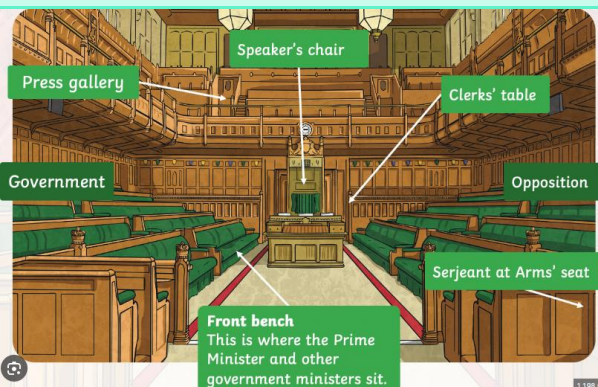
**Critical consumer**- Critical consumers take responsibility for the environmental, social and political effects of their choices

**Government** - The Government runs the country and has responsibility for developing and implementing policy and for drafting laws

**Parliament** - Made up of the House of Commons and the House of Lords, its role is to: look at what the government is doing. debate issues and pass new laws.

**Enterprise** - A difficult, complicated, or risky project or undertaking.
